Subject: clarifications

1. There is a Carlebach minyan in shul tonight. They will daven Mincha in the main shul and then move to the Beis Midrash for Kabbalas Shabbos.
2. The 7 PM minyan on Motzaeh Shabbos will take place in the Beis Midrash. Megilla is at 7:10 and there will be no noisemaking.

The 7:30 PM minyan is the "family minyan". It allows families to drive back to shul after Shabbos. It also gives kids time to put on their costumes. Costumes should not be prepared on Shabbos for Purim.

There is another reading in shul at 9:15 PM

In the morning the 7AM minyan will also have no noisemaking.
